Why participate?

Save money

According to the American Automobile Association, commuters pay about \$58 for every 100 miles travelled to work. Driving fewer miles equals money saved.

Keep our air clean

Leave your car at home twice a weeks during the challenge, and if your commute is 20 miles round trip, you'll prevent about 272 pounds of harmful emissions that contribute to ozone pollution.
